### **MOODY AIR FORCE BASE**

#### **LGBTea Time**

LGBTea Time is a quarterly social event with varying themes. This event may give attendees a setting to discuss issues in the community while enjoying refreshments, a fun gathering for the queer community to learn something new, or just a relaxed social event. Past LGBTea Times included: World AIDS Day Gala, a discussion of trans and nonbinary issues, and a back-to-school barbeque.

### SPONSORSHIP BENEFITS ADDITIONAL DETAILS

[1] Sponsorship funds must be received at least 30 days prior to the Festival to allow for printing and ordering times. Annual items are released during the SGP Festival in September.

[2] Shine level: Announcement made on stage at either Music and Art on Main or SGP Festival in Saunders Park. Glow level announcements occurs at all events following receipt of sponsorship funds during the fiscal year.

[3] Thank you Prize Pack consists of 2 SGP shirts in the sizes of your choice and a selection of other items.

[4] Event banners printed and displayed at Music and Art on Main and the annual SGP Festival. Sponsorship funds must be received 30 days prior to the event to allow for printing and ordering times.

[5] Booth space is 10 ft x 10 ft. Vendor must provide their own tent and tables. Spaces with electricity available on first come, first serve basis.
